

Rain Barrel Education Program

The Lower Merion Township Environmental Advisory Council is working with local environmental and civic groups to offer a rain barrel program. Would you like to learn how to install and use a rain barrel? Rain barrels have been used by many people for years to collect rain water for beneficial re-use like watering gardens, reducing stormwater runoff, and even drinking water under certain circumstances. Using a rain barrel can reduce your water usage and save money on your water and sewer bills.

The cost of the program is **\$69** and includes attendance at an educational seminar and one barrel. Additional barrels may be purchased for **\$69**. Note that attending the education program is not required, so if you don't want to attend and just want the rain barrel, please indicate on the form below.

Location: Lower Merion Township Building, 75 E. Lancaster Avenue, Ardmore, PA

Deadline for receipt of application: February 19, 2010

Barrels will be available for pickup the day of the education seminar and arrangements may be made if you cannot pick up at this time.

The program is NOT limited to Lower Merion Township residents and business owners may participate.
