On April 28, 2020 at approximately 9:05am, a middle-aged white male was running west across City Avenue, north of Overbrook Parkway, when he was struck by a vehicle that was travelling southbound on City Avenue. The striking vehicle came to rest south of Overbrook Parkway.

The driver remained on scene and has cooperated throughout this investigation.

The pedestrian was initially treated at the scene by Narberth Ambulance. He was transported to Lankenau Hospital for further medical treatment but died as a result of injuries sustained in the crash.

The pedestrian's identity is currently unknown. He is described as a middle-aged white male possibly in his fifties or sixties with close cropped hair. He has a medium build and is approximately 6 foot tall. He was wearing two T-shirts; one red 2008 Phillies Champions and one rose colored Free Brady (New England Patriots Football attire). His pants are described as blue Adidas sweatpants with white stripes. He also had on size 11 blue Asics GT-2000 running sneakers.
